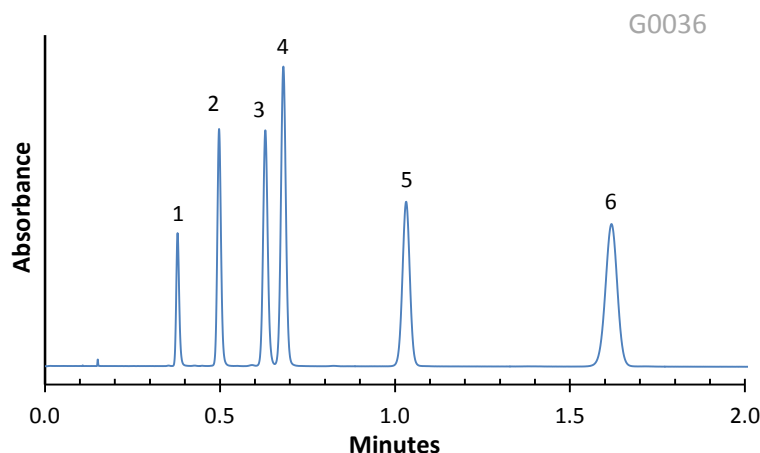

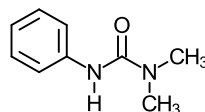

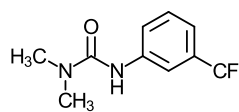

 B=Acetonitrile
 Flow Rate: 2.0 mL/min.
 Pressure: 200 Bar
 Temperature: 20 °C
 Detection: UV 245 nm, VWD
 Injection Volume: 0.5 µL
 Sample Solvent: Acetonitrile/water
 Response Time: 0.02 sec.
 Flow Cell: 2.5 µL semi-micro
 LC System: Shimadzu Prominence UFLC XR
 Extra column volume: ~14 µL

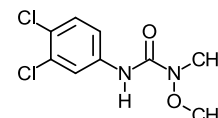

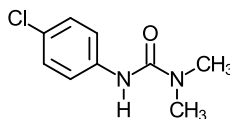
Fenuron



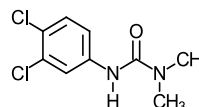
Fluomethuron



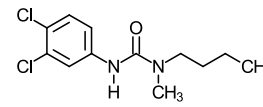
